These notices may supplement or clarify BESS/ BIOENERGON's privacy practices or may provide you with additional choices about how BESS/ BIOENERGON processes your data.

If you do not agree with or you are not comfortable with any aspect of this Privacy Policy, you should immediately discontinue access or use of our Services.

BioEnergion Green Energy Ltd is a limited liability company incorporated in England and Wales under the company number 0714519 and is headquartered at Birchin Court, 20 Birchin Lane, London EC3V 9DJ, United Kingdom.

BioEnergion is the initiator and publisher of the **BESS Coin Token/ICO**, an Ethereum basis token for direct or indirect participation in BESS Power Plants developed, by BioEnergion.

BioEnergion recommends the transactions for participation in BESS tokens via the secure homepage <https://www.bess-coin-mining.com/#howto> to the homepage "Coinbase Payments, Ltd",, an authorized e-money institution authorized and regulated by the UK Financial Conduct Authority ("FCA"), registration number 900635.

Coinbase UK, Ltd, is a limited liability company registered in England and Wales, company number 09083955, located at 9th floor, 107 Cheapside, London, EC2V 6DN. Coinbase UK, Ltd, based in the United Kingdom, handles transactions in digital currency originating in the EEA. Coinbase UK, Ltd is the data controller for cryptocurrency transactions.

BESS/ BIOENERGON and Coinbase have their own privacy policy after EEA.

THE PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Personal information is data that can be used to identify you directly or indirectly, or to contact you.

Our Privacy Policy covers all personal information that you voluntarily submit to us or that we obtain from our partners.

This Privacy Policy does not apply to anonymised data, as it cannot be used to identify you. You may be asked to provide personal information when you contact BESS/ BIOENERGON or its affiliates.

BESS/ BIOENERGON companies may share your personal information with affiliates and use them in accordance with this privacy policy.

BESS/ BIOENERGON can also combine it with other information to provide and enhance the products, services and content.

Except as described in this Privacy Policy, BESS/ BIOENERGON will not disclose, sell, rent or lend personal information to third parties.

PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTED

We collect personal information to provide you with our Services.

When we require certain personal information from users it is because we are required by law to collect this information or it is relevant for specified purposes. Any information you provide to us that is not required is voluntary.

You may choose to provide us with any requested personal information, but you may not be able to serve you effectively or offer you all of our services should you fail to share certain information with us.

We collect personal information when you use or request information about our services, request support, or sign up for a BESS/ BIOENERGON event or viewing.

We may also collect personal information from you offline, such as: For example, if you attend one of our events or if you contact Customer Service.

We collect the following types of information:

- **Personal Identification Information:** Full name, date of birth, age, nationality, gender, signature, utility bills, photographs, phone number, home address, and/or email.
- **Transaction Information:** Information about the transactions you make on our Services, such as the name of the recipient, your name, the amount, and/or timestamp.
- **Online Identifiers:** Geo location/tracking details, browser fingerprint, OS, browser name and version, and/or personal IP addresses.

HOW YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION IS USED

The primary purpose in collecting personal information is to provide you with a secure, smooth, efficient, and customised experience.

In general, we use personal information to create, develop, operate, deliver, and improve our Services, content and advertising, and for loss prevention and anti-fraud purposes.

We may use this information in the following ways:

TO MAINTAIN LEGAL AND REGULATORY COMPLIANCE

Some of our core Services are subject to laws and regulations requiring us to collect and use your personal identification information, formal identification information, financial information, transaction information, employment information, online identifiers, and/or usage data in certain ways.

For example, BESS/ BIOENERGON must identify and verify customers using our

Services in order to comply with anti-money laundering and terrorist financing laws across jurisdictions.

EEA Residents: For individuals who reside in the European Economic Area (including the United Kingdom) or Switzerland (collectively “EEA Residents”), pursuant to Article 6 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) or any equivalent legislation (collectively “EEA Data Protection Law”), we process this personal information to comply with our legal obligations.

- **To provide Service communications**

We send administrative or account-related information to you to keep you updated about our Services, inform you of relevant security issues or updates, or provide other transaction-related information. Without such communications, you may not be aware of important developments relating to your account that may affect how you can use our Services.

- **To engage in marketing activities**

Based on your communication preferences, we may send you marketing communications to inform you about our events.

We will not use your personal information for purposes other than those purposes we have disclosed to you, without your permission.

HOW WE PROTECT AND STORE PERSONAL INFORMATION

We understand how important your privacy is, which is why BESS/ BIOENERGON maintains appropriate physical, technical and administrative safeguards to protect the security and confidentiality of the personal information you entrust to us.

We protect your personal information by maintaining physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards in compliance with the applicable laws and regulations.

For example, we use computer safeguards such as firewalls and data encryption, we enforce physical access controls to our buildings and files, and we authorise access to personal information only for those employees who require it to fulfill their job responsibilities.

Full credit card data is securely transferred and hosted off-site by a payment vendor in compliance with Payment Card Industry Data Security Standards (PCI DSS). This information is not accessible to BESS/ BIOENERGON staff.

However, we cannot guarantee that loss, misuse, unauthorised acquisition, or alteration of your data will not occur. Please recognise that you play a vital role in protecting your own personal information.

When registering with our Services, it is important to choose a password of sufficient length and complexity, to not reveal this password to any third-parties, and to immediately notify us if you become aware of any unauthorised access to or use of your account.

In addition, we can't guarantee the security or confidentiality of any information you send us or receive from us over the Internet or a wireless connection, including e-mail, telephone or SMS, as we have no way of obtaining this information while the data is being transmitted can't protect.

If you have reason to believe that your personal information is not kept safe, please contact us at the email address, mailing address or telephone number listed at the end of this Privacy Policy.

HOW YOU CAN ACCESS OR CHANGE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

You are entitled to review, correct, or amend your personal information, or to delete that information where it is inaccurate.

You may do this at any time by logging in to your account and clicking the Profile or My Account tab.

If you close your BESS/ BIOENERGON Account, we will mark your account in our database as "Closed," but will keep your account information in our database for a period of time described above.

This is necessary in order to deter fraud, by ensuring that persons who try to commit fraud will not be able to avoid detection simply by closing their account and opening a new account.

However, if you close your account, we will not use your personal information for further purposes, or sell or disclose it to third parties, except to the extent necessary to prevent fraud or law enforcement assistance, as required by law or pursuant to this Privacy Policy.

RIGHTS IN RELATION TO THE USE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Rights of access, correction and deletion

You have a right of access to the personal information that we hold about you under European data protection legislation, and to some related information. You can also require any inaccurate personal information to be corrected or deleted.

Right to object

You may, at any time, object to the use of your personal information for direct marketing purposes, and you may have the right, in certain circumstances, to object to the processing of some or all of your personal information and request that it be deleted.

If you would like to exercise any of these rights, please contact us.

RETENTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We store your personal information securely throughout the life of your BESS/ BIOENERGON Account.

We will only retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which we collected it, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting obligations or to resolve disputes.

While retention requirements vary by jurisdiction, information about our typical retention periods for different aspects of your personal information are described below.

- Contact information for marketing purposes, such as your name, email address, and phone number, will be retained until you log out..
- Content that you post on our website such as support desk comments, photographs, videos, blog posts, and other content may be kept indefinitely after you close your account for audit and crime prevention purposes.
- Information collected via technical means such as cookies, webpage counters and other analytics tools is kept for a period of up to one year from expiry of the cookie.

EEA USERS & DATA

If you are a resident of the EEA, BESS/ BIOENERGON Ltd are joint controllers with respect to your personal information. As joint controllers, these entities determine the means and purposes of processing data in relation to BESS/ BIOENERGON-Wallet- und - BES Cryptocurrency-Transaktionen.

Legal bases for processing personal information

Our legal bases for processing under EEA Data Protection Law are described above in the sections entitled “How Your Information Is Used” and “Information From Third Party Partners.”

We can process your personal information if

- you agree to the processing,
- we comply with our legal obligations,
- fulfill obligations arising from contracts that we have concluded with you
- and / or at your request before entering into a contract, take steps to protect our legitimate interests in our property, rights or safety of BESS/ BIOENERGON or our customers.

Direct Marketing

If you are a current customer residing in the EEA , we will only contact you by electronic means (email or SMS) with information about our Services that are similar to those which were the subject of a previous sale or negotiations of a sale to you.

If you are a new customer and located in the EEA , we will contact you if you are located in the EU by electronic means for marketing purposes only if you have consented to such communication.

If you do not want us to use your personal information in the manner described or to share your personal information with others for marketing purposes, please contact us at info1@bess-coin-mining.com.

You may submit this objection at any time for initial or further processing for direct marketing purposes.

Direct marketing includes any communications to you that are only based on advertising or promoting products and services

Individual Rights

EEA residents have the following rights that can be exercised by contacting us at info1@bess-coin-mining.com to review your request in accordance with applicable law.

- **Right to withdraw consent.** You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal information collected on the basis of your consent at any time.
- **Right to delete.**
You have the right to request the deletion of your personal data, which:
 - (a) no longer necessary in relation to the purposes for which they were collected or otherwise processed;
 - (b) have been collected in relation to the processing that you have previously agreed but later withdraw such consent;or
 - (c) have been collected in relation to any processing activity you object to and there are no legitimate grounds for our processing.
- **Right to data portability.**
If we process your personal information on the basis of a contract with you or on your consent, or if the processing is automated, you may request your personal data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, or we will transfer your personal data directly to a "controller", to the extent that is technically possible and that the rights and freedoms of others are not affected.
A "Controller" is a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of your personal information.

- **Right to restriction of or processing.**

You have the right to restrict or object to us processing your personal information where one of the following applies:

- (a) You contest the accuracy of your personal information that we processed. In such instances, we will restrict processing during the period necessary for us to verify the accuracy of your personal information.
- (b) The processing is unlawful and you oppose the erasure of your personal information and request the restriction of its use instead.
- (c) We no longer need your personal information for the purposes of the processing, but it is required by you to establish, exercise or defense of legal claims.
- (d) You have objected to processing, pending the verification whether the legitimate grounds of Coinbase's processing override your rights.

Restricted personal information shall only be processed with your consent or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims or for the protection of the rights of another natural or legal person or for reasons of important public interest. We will inform you if the restriction is lifted.

- **Notification of erasure, rectification and restriction.** We will communicate any rectification or erasure of your personal information or restriction of processing to each recipient to whom your personal information have been disclosed, unless this proves impossible or involves disproportionate effort. We will inform you about those recipients if you request this information.
- **Right to object to processing.** Where the processing of your personal information is based on consent, contract or legitimate interests you may restrict or object, at any time, to the processing of your personal information as permitted by applicable law. We can continue to process your personal information if it is necessary for the defense of legal claims, or for any other exceptions permitted by applicable law.
- **Automated individual decision-making, including profiling.** You have the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing of your personal information, including profiling, which produces legal or similarly significant effects on you, save for the exceptions applicable under relevant data protection laws.
- **Right to lodge a complaint.**

- Where the request is frivolous or vexatious.
